Common eligibility for all categories of pensions:

- Total family income should be less than Rs. 10000/- per month in Rural areas and Rs. 12000/- per month in Urban areas.
- Age should be as per Aadhaar card.
- Total land holding of the family should be less than 3.00 acres of wet (or) 10.00 acres of dry (or) 10.00 acres of both wet and dry land together.
- Family should not own a four-wheeler (Taxi, Tractors, Autos are exempted).
- No family member should be Government employee or Pensioner.

- Monthly electricity consumption of a family dwelling unit (own/rent) should be less than 300 units per month.
- Family in municipal areas who owns less than 1000 sq ft of built-up area.
- No family member should be an income tax payee.

One pension will be allowed in the family except in the following conditions:

- Family having disabled person with 80% and above degree of disability.
- Dialysis patients (CKDU) / Severe Mental Retardation/PLHIV (ART).
- Pensions sanctioned vide GO Rt.No.551 HM&FW Department, dated 26.10.2019 and Memo No: 3033401/D1/2019, of HM&FW Department, dt:08.11.2019.

Priority shall be given to:

- SC households.
- Practicing Artisans (Weavers, Toddy Tappers, Barbers, Washer men, Potters, Blacksmith, Carpenter, Cobbler, Animal herder, Village Artists etc) and other Back Ward Classes
- Daily labourers (Daily wage labourers, Agricultural Labourers, Migrated labourers)
- Nomadic Tribes having no permanent residence
- Households with destitute / orphans.
- Households with Disabled.
- Other poor Households
